



Notice of A5 Hints Bypass overnight and lane closures

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

We'll be carrying out overnight and lane closures on the A5 Hints Bypass

We'll be carrying out a series of closures between Weeford Interchange and Fazeley on the A5, enabling us to prepare for the construction of the HS2 railway line, taking it under the A5.

A5 Eastbound closure: overnight closures from Monday 10 January to Wednesday 12 January from 9pm – 5.30am

A5 Westbound diversion route: overnight closures from Wednesday 12 January to Friday 14 January from 9pm – 5.30am

Following on from these closures, a single lane will run westbound until March 2022. Further works are expected, and we will update you with this information once we can confirm the dates.

Whilst the overnight closures are in place, there will be a clearly signed diversion route in place. The diversion routes have been provided on a map on the following page.

A cycle path diversion will be in place

To ensure the safety of the local community during this programme, we will temporarily close the cycle path along the A5 from Monday 10 January until March 2023. A diversion will be in place for the duration, taking cyclists along Hints Road, Roman Road, Watling Street and Rock Hill.

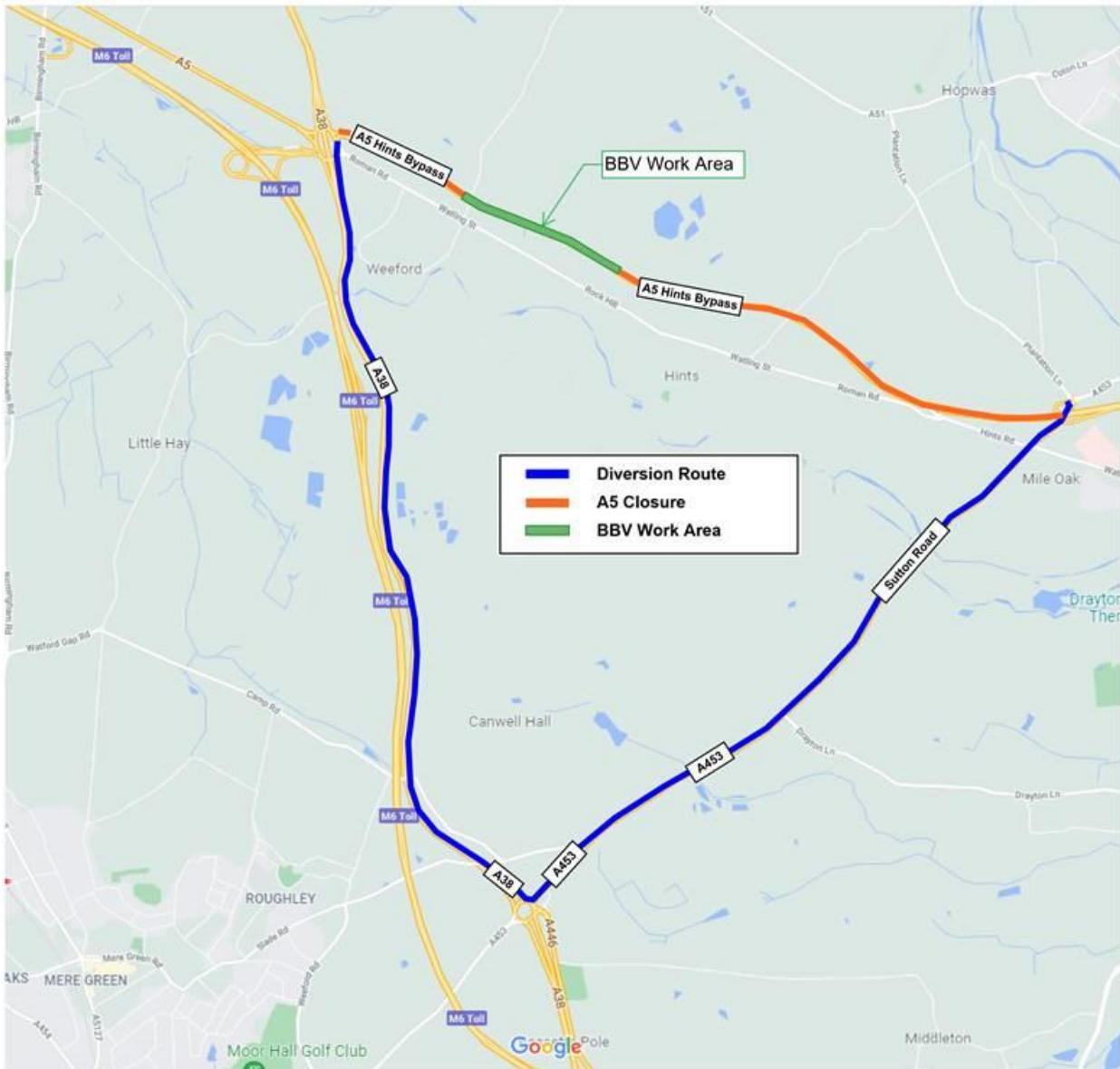

The map below details the A5 Hints Bypass closure and diversion route that will be in place during the overnight closures and for abnormal loads.

A5 Eastbound diversion route: traffic will be diverted along the A38 London Road to Bassetts Pole roundabout and onto the A453 Sutton Road.

A5 Westbound diversion route: traffic will be diverted onto A453 Sutton Road to Bassetts Pole roundabout and onto the A38 London Road.

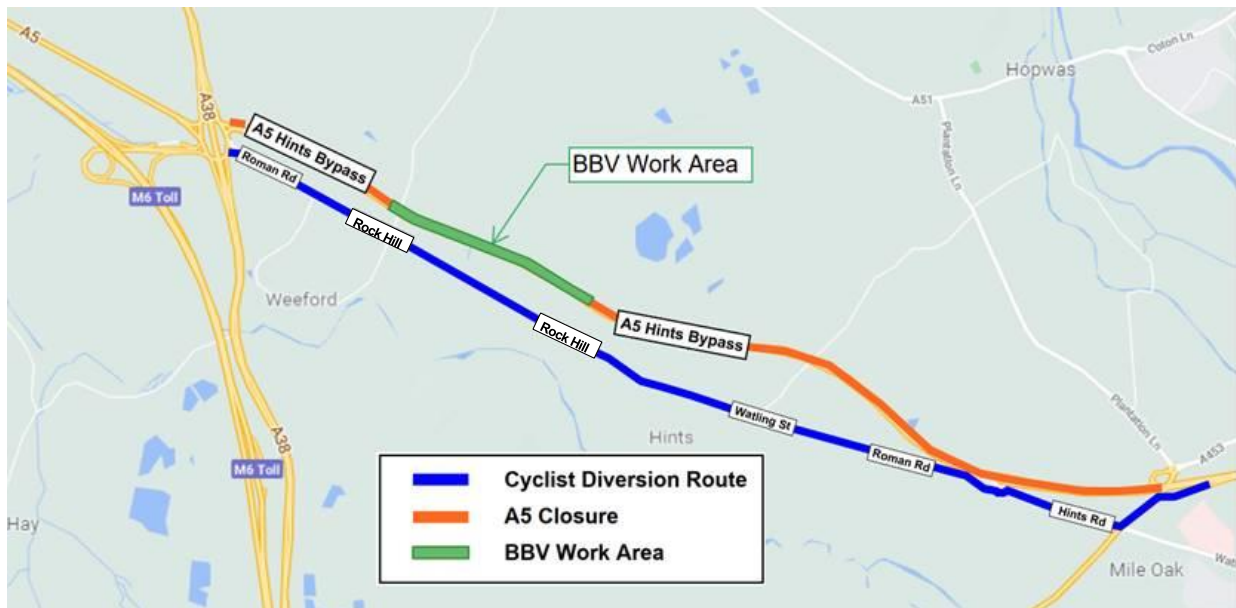
