



Reporting Online to Staffordshire Police

Your latest Smart Alert.

Are you aware you can now report incidents online to Staffordshire Police? There are two ways of doing this:

1) Via Facebook - to do this type in "Staffordshire Police" in the search bar, click the Staffordshire Police page and once you are on there you can click on the private message button which is next to the "contact us" button. This can be done on computers and also on the Facebook phone app.

2) Via the Staffordshire Police website - type in www.staffordshire.police.uk in the URL search bar and click onto the website. Once the page is loaded you will see a "report" bar on the opening page, once you click on this you will get several options regarding what crime/incident you want to report. Once you have chosen your incident follow the simple steps to report.

Police Contact Advice:

Telephone 999 in an emergency where there is a danger to life or a crime is in progress.

Telephone 101 for **non**-emergencies where police attendance is required, to report a crime or to report any other incidents. Calls to 101 have a fixed cost of 15p per call.
